

Director Guidance for New Employees (March 2024)

For all new employees, Directors, please complete the <u>New Employee Form</u> . Upon submitting, the system will generate an email to Rob Hillman, Lisa Rivera, and Jenny Verdugo. Lisa and Jenny will follow up with you and the new employee as follows:
Web App: Lisa will confirm with the Director that the new employee has completed the Data Security and MSIX Training and then set up a Web App account.
Newsletter/Professional Development Announcement Distribution List and Website: Jenny will add the new employee's institutional email address to the to the distribution list. She will then email the new employee, copying the Director, and attach the <u>New Employee Welcome Letter</u> on behalf of the State. Additionally, Jenny will set up a NYS-MEP website account and offer to meet with the employee, via Zoom, for a tour of the website to call out specific and timely resources.
When a new Data Specialist (DS) is hired, please email Odilia Coffta (Odilia.Coffta@oneonta.edu), and copy Lisa Rivera (Lisa.Rivera@oneonta.edu). Odilia will provide training for Web App. Lisa will set up the account.
ID&R Issued Devices: If the new employee will be using a device issued by ID&R, please complete the <u>Device Assignment Form</u> . This is important to keep inventory records current. Rob Hillman will initiate an <i>Equipment Loan Agreement</i> that both the new employee and Will Messier will sign. The signed copy will be sent to the METS Director.
