The High School Online Leadership Academy (HOLA) is a summer program sponsored by the New York State Migrant Education Program (NYS-MEP). It provides eligible migrant students with the opportunity to learn about college, work possibilities, leadership qualities, and successful life strategies as they work towards graduating high school.

Students explore various life skills, learn about leveraging their individual strengths, and create a long-term plan to work on areas of personal growth that reflects their passions and interests.

### Instruction

Take the opportunity to experience classes led by college professors and learn alongside other migrant students in a supportive environment.

### Leadership

Understand and develop leadership skills, and engage in activities to explore your potential.

### Mentorship

Build relationships and receive one-on-one support from bilingual staff in small learning groups.

### Flexibility

Plan your class schedule around your daily commitments, and choose the times that work best for you.



## Program Information

The High School Online Leadership Academy (HOLA) is sponsored by the NYS Migrant Education Program (NYS-MEP), which provides instructional and support services to migrant eligible students.

HOLA is an eight-day, virtual summer program, hosted on Zoom and using Google Classroom as the platform for classwork and assignments.

- Instruction from certified educators
- Exciting activities and meaningful leadership workshops
- One-on-one support from counselors and staff

## Who Can Apply?

- Currently eligible migrant high school students, entering grades 9-12.
- Students able to actively commit to eight days of academic activities with 3-5 hours of work per day



NYS-MEP high school students are eligible to participate in HOLA. This is a value of over **\$2000** per student!

The New York State Migrant Education Program believes in each student and invests in them, knowing that HOLA is a great jumpstart to students' futures. Don't miss this opportunity!

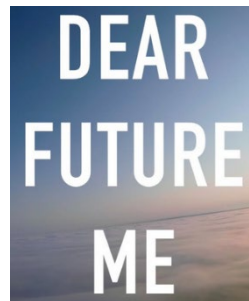
## Explore YOUR Future!
