

## **CHOOSING A BOOK**

- MAKE SURE IT IS HIGH QUALITY, LOOK FOR <u>NATIONAL AWARD WINNERS</u> <u>IN THEIR LANGUAGE</u> OR POPULAR AUTHORS
- IT MUST BE A TOPIC OF HIGH INTEREST, HELP STUDENTS SEE THEMSELVES
- ENSURE IT IS DEVELOPMENTALLY APPROPRIATE AND AT THE CHILD'S LISTENING LEVEL

## THINGS TO REMEMBER

- ACTIVATE YOUR STUDENT'S THINKING BEFORE READING, SET THE STAGE
- KNOW WHAT YOUR GOALS FOR THE READ ALOUD ARE, PLAN AHEAD
- AIM FOR "ACCEPT-IONAL" READ ALOUD TIME
- USE YOUR TOOLS TO MAKE IT INTERACTIVE
- GIVE STUDENT CHOICES WHENEVER POSSIBLE
- ASK IF THIS TEXT WITH YOUR PRESENTATION WILL MOTIVATE THE STUDENT
