Who can participate?

CAMP Eligibility:

- Student must be a U.S. Citizen or have a valid Permanent Resident status
- Must have a financial and academic need
- On track to graduate and receive a high school diploma or equivalent (GED)
- Applicant is/was eligible to receive services from Title 1- Migrant Education Programs
- Applicant or immediate family member must have performed a minimum of 75 days of seasonal or temporary farm work within the last 2 years.
- Can be eligible if they have documentation through NFJP
