easyCBM Passage Reading Fluency (PRF) and Proficient Math (Prof Mth) Assessment Reminder Recap for 2023-24

 - If the security page loads when logging into easyCBM, click the "continue" prompt to access the website.

- Test all Level 2 and Level 3 students in grades 3-8.
- The ELA Assessment for students in grades 3-8 is Passage Reading Fluency (PRF). Passage Reading Fluency (PRF) scores need to be entered by staff.
- The Math Assessment for students in grades 3-8 is Proficient Math (Prof Mth). Proficient Math test scores need to be entered if the test is given in-person. Scores will automatically be saved in easyCBM if the test is given virtually.
- All PRF and Prof Mth scores need to be entered by Staff on or before October 13, 2023.
- Entering Services in WebApp for easyCBM assessment administration: PRF = ELA; Mth Prof = Math
- If a student is unable to answer any test question, then the Migrant Educator should revisit at a future session for a maximum of three attempts. If a student is unable to answer questions after 3 attempts, enter zero (0) for the pre-test score.
- Use the Winter Benchmark Testing Period (January 2, 2024 February 23, 2024) to test any student who was NOT tested in the fall or is a NEW student.
- Use activities and tools available in the ELA Resource Library, including the Student Literacy Profile to support instruction.
