

Examples of Acceptable Documents to Prove why you are Eligible for the COVID-19 Vaccination in New York State

If you are eligible for the vaccine because of your job, you need proof that you work at an eligible job in New York State.

Proof of your job may include:

- An employee ID card or badge;
- A letter from your employer or the company you work for; or
- A pay stub.

If you are eligible for the vaccine because of your age, you need proof of your age **and** proof that you live in New York State.

Proof of your age may include:

- Driver's license or non-driver ID;
- Birth certificate;
- Current passport (U.S. or other country);
- Permanent resident card;
- Certificate of Naturalization or Citizenship; or
- Marriage certificate with birthday.

For proof that you live in New York State, you can have either:

- **ONE (1) of the following documents:**
 - A statement from the landlord where you live;
 - A current rent receipt; or
 - A lease agreement or mortgage records;

OR

- **TWO (2) of the following documents:**
 - A reference letter from someone you know that says where you live; and/or
 - A stamped envelope with your name and address on it; and/or
 - School records (if you are in school).

If you are a candidate to receive the vaccine because of a health condition, you can sign a form at the vaccination site, attesting that you have an eligible health condition.

- By signing the form, you are certifying your current health status.
