WHO WE SERVE

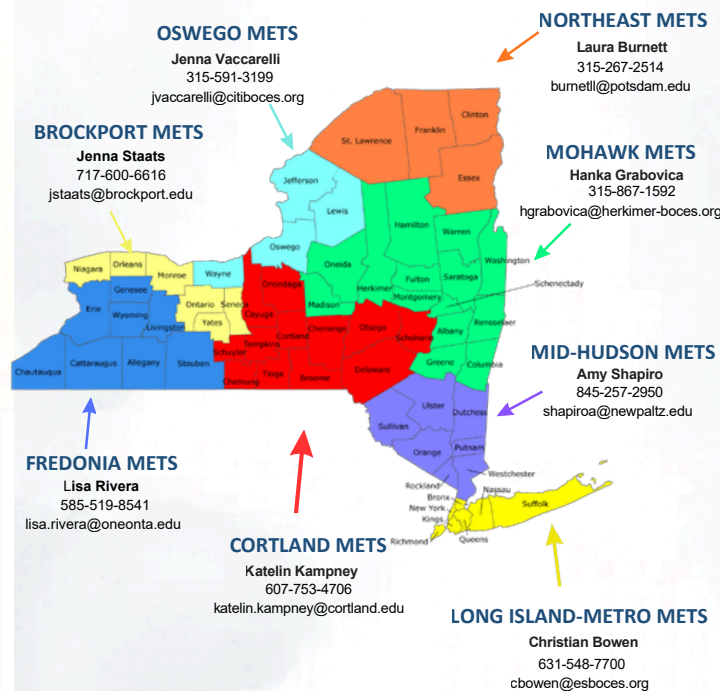
We serve children (up to age 21) who:
